

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT


On September 23, 2011 Plaintiff, Vicki Wood filed a Motion for voluntary dismissal of complaint in the above stated proceeding.

Pursuant to St. Regis Mohawk Tribe TCR-2008-20, Rules of Civil Procedure, [hereinafter SRMT Civ. Pro.]:

A Judge shall allow Plaintiff to Withdraw the Complaint and shall dismiss the case at any time Plaintiff requests... (See, §X(B) [Rule 7]).

Since dismissal would not be unfair to the Defendant nor has there been a counterclaim, the Plaintiff's Motion to Withdraw Complaint is GRANTED Without Prejudice.
