ABSENTEE BALLOTS AVAILABLE AT TRIBAL CLERK'S OFFICE

ST. REGIS MOHAWK TRIBE – Absentee ballots will be available starting Wednesday, March 26, 2008 for the April 5 Referendum on the New Governance Structure. The Saint Regis Mohawk Tribal Clerk's Office will be providing voting services for homebound elderly and disabled community members. This service can be scheduled by appointment only.

At the time of voting an eligible voter must:

- A. Be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
- B. Be an enrolled member of the Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe.
- C. Reside in the United States for at least six months immediately prior to the election.
- D. Have their name on the most current eligible voters list.

To schedule an appointment, obtain a ballot or check your voting eligibility, please contact the Tribal Clerk's Office at 518-358-2272. Absentee ballots will be accepted until noon on April 5th.
