U.S. Census Bureau Surveys Being Conducted

Akwesasne Territory. During the next three weeks, a U.S. Census subcontractor, HumRRO will be visiting 100 randomly-selected homes on the St. Regis Indian Reservation to conduct surveys as part of a research study.

The survey questions do not require that you provide any personal information and are meant to collect general data that can be used to improve future U.S. Census Bureau strategies in raising awareness of, and providing education on the U.S. Census process. Every selected household will receive a \$10.00 cash gift for participating in the survey.

Households selected to participate randomly should have received a letter in the mail with information about the study. The two interviewers, Alec and Doreen, will each be wearing a name card badge that will clearly identify them as representatives of HumRRO. HumRRO did request and receive permission from the St. Regis Mohawk Tribe to come onto the territory to conduct the survey, which includes only those homes located within the southern portion of Akwesasne.
