INVESTIGATION OF HOUSEHOLD DUST
FOR
DIOXINS AND DIOXIN LIKE CHEMICALS IN AKWESASNE**

PURPOSE

The Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe (SRMT) is requesting proposals from a qualified environmental consultant/firm to analyze statistical data and develop a report to reveal whether the Akwesasne community is affected by the remediation activities at the former General Motors site.

BRIEF PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Air Quality Program (AQP), Environment Division, will provide contract support to the USEPA. AQP will take dust samples from 25 community members' homes (2 samples from each home) from five (5) pre-determined areas of Akwesasne. The samples will be handled in accordance to an approved Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) and shall comply with an approved Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP).

This project is intended to measure the concentration of dioxins and dioxin-like chemicals in household dust in the Akwesasne Community through funding from the USEPA.

Proposals will be received until 3:30 p.m. (LOCAL TIME), MONDAY April 25, 2016.

Deadline for submission of written questions is Wednesday April 20, 2016.
