### **FCCW Wrestling Event Not Sanctioned By Tribe**

*Venue and Event not Licensed*

**Akwasasne Territory.** An event, (Break Out) FCCW Pro Wrestling scheduled for Saturday July 17, 2010 at the *All Inn Lounge* is not a sanctioned event under the St. Regis Mohawk Tribe's Department of Athletic Regulation. Tribal Council Resolution, TCR 2009-057, adopted by the St. Regis Mohawk Tribe, assigns the authority to the tribe's Compliance Department to regulate athletic events such as boxing, martial arts, including wrestling.

Such events require safety inspections and regulations to ensure compliance with all applicable Tribal laws including and not limited to fire code, building codes and athletic regulations that ensure contestants are competing under the safest circumstances.

According to the St. Regis Mohawk Tribe's Compliance Department the "Break Out" Pro Wrestling event is NOT in compliance with applicable Tribal Laws. The promoter has not remitted applications for permits for the event and has not received Tribal Council's approval. Therefore, the All Inn Lounge location is not within compliance with applicable Tribal laws and regulations.

Ultimately, the St. Regis Mohawk Tribe does not assume any liability or responsibility for any accidents or incidents, foreseen or unforeseen, that may occur as a result of attendance or participation at the event scheduled for July 17, 2010.
