Mohawk Police to Investigate Boat Collision

Akwesasne Territory – The St. Regis Mohawk Tribe, Mohawk Council of Akwesasne, and Mohawk Nation Council of Chiefs met late this afternoon to discuss the boat collision that occurred late Monday night seriously injuring two Akwesasronon.

At this meeting, the St. Regis Mohawk Tribal Council announced that it has directed the St. Regis Mohawk Tribal Police to investigate the boat collision and that the Tribal Police will be working with the Akwesasne Mohawk Police in conducting the investigation.

The U.S Coast Guard, whose boat was involved in the collision with the Akwesasronon boat, has agreed to suspend their operations on the water while the Tribal investigation is conducted.

The Akwesasne leadership is asking the community to remain calm while this investigation is conducted. Anyone with information related to the incident is asked to contact the St. Regis Mohawk Tribal Police at 518-358-9200 or the Akwesasne Mohawk Police at 613-575-2340.

Akwesasne leadership will release more information about the incident as it becomes available.
