In 2008, The Saint Regis Mohawk Tribal Council passed a resolution to reaffirm their commitment to the preservation and use of the *Kanienkehaka* language and facilitating the growth of speakers in the community. The Language program has been reorganized with input from community members and tribal employees to make classes more accessible.

The courses are free of charge and potential students are asked only that they commit to completing the 10-week cycle. This first cycle will accept adults at all levels of fluency and begin the week of July 24th.
