Proposed Multi-Purpose Trail System
St. Lawrence Flatlands Management Unit,
Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)**

The Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe, Environment Division, received notice from the NYSDEC that the St. Lawrence Flatlands Management Unit, Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the proposed multi-purpose trail system in the St. Lawrence Flatlands management unit (e.g. Brasher State Forest) has been prepared and is available for comments.

The Draft EIS was prepared in accordance with the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) to analyze environmental impacts resulting from the construction of proposed multi-use recreational trails, e.g. ATV trails in the St. Lawrence Flatlands Unit Management Planning Area that includes the Brasher State forest as well as Bombay, Buckton, and Ft. Jackson State Forests.
