TRIBAL POLICE LOOK INTO REMOVAL OF BORDER MARKER

Federal Agencies Contacted

Akwesasne Territory— On Friday, October 30, 2009, a group of people removed a U.S. – Canadian border marker located in Akwesasne Territory. The St. Regis Mohawk Tribal police were called and went to the scene. They made a traffic stop on the vehicle that was towing the monument away on a trailer. However, when it was determined that the property was owned by the federal government (and not U.S. Customs) the tribal police made the decision to monitor the situation and refer all information over to the appropriate federal agency for the investigation. To date, no federal agency has called to investigate the incident.
