VOTERS ELECT TRIBAL SUB-CHIEF *Pamela Brown Unofficial Top Vote-Getter*

Akwesasne Territory — The Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe held a special tribal elections this past weekend, with some 325 ballots cast for the open position of Tribal Sub-Chief. Voting took place in the lobby of the Tribe's Community Building from 9am- 5pm on Saturday, August 23, 2008.

The unofficial election results were made available by the Tribal Election Board about one and one-half hours after the polls closed and showed Pamela Brown being elected to a three-year term as Tribal Sub-Chief.

Brown won the vacant seat as Tribal Sub-Chief with a total of 101 votes. Eighty-three ballots were cast in support of Brown during the day of the tribal election, with 18 absentee ballots. Agatha Thompson received 87 votes on Saturday and 11 votes by absentee ballots for a total of 98.

Brendan White garnered 60 total votes (55 ballots with 5 absentee). Wade James McDonald received 31 votes and 5 absentee ballots in his bid for Sub-Chief, receiving a total 36 votes. Hollis White 21 received votes on election day, with one absentee ballot submitted in his favor. One vote was cast for Dan White as a write-in. Five ballots were void and two were spoiled.
