

RECYCLING PREPARATION GUIDE

PAYT PROGRAM

MATERIAL	HOW TO PREPARE	DO NOT INCLUDE THESE MATERIALS
Glass Mirrors, clear, brown, and green glass, crystal, window glass, ceramics, incandescent	Rinse clean. Remove and discard lids and caps.	Window glass in frames. Flourescent light bulbs.
Aluminum & Tin Food, beverage & other containers, foil, and pie tins.	Rinse clean.	Aerosol cans, pressurized cans, oil cans, and paint cans.
Plastic Bottles & Jugs Pourable plastic bottles & jugs. For example: milk jugs, dish & laundry detergent bottles. Look for a 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 on the bottom.	Rinse clean. Remove and discard lids and caps.	Plastic bags, cups, tubs, and jars. Plastic trays, pails, or clam shells. Styrofoam. Plastic bottles with the numbers 6 or 7 on the bottom.
Mixed Paper See list below.	Keep clean & dry.	See list below. When in doubt, throw it out.

Acceptable Mixed Paper Materials

Corrugated cardboard, computer paper, white & colored office paper, facsimile paper, magazines, catalogs, paper grocery bags, junk mail, all envelopes, labels, dry paperboard boxes (food boxes, cereal boxes, tissue boxes, and rollers). Egg cartons, newspapers and newspaper inserts, file cards, and folders, writing or note paper, telephone books, paperback books, and soft drink and beer containers.

Non-Acceptable Mixed Paper Materials

Carbon paper, waxed paper, milk cartons, inner liners in paperboard boxes, padded envelopes, paper plates, napkins and tissues, styrofoam containers, and pizza boxes.



FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO RECYCLE YOUR MATERIALS

1. Prepare your materials according the instructions located on the back of this sheet.
2. Combine glass, plastics, tin and aluminum. Keep these materials separate from mixed paper.
3. Combine mixed paper and keep separate from glass, plastic, tin and aluminum.
4. Take all materials to the Tribe's recycling depot located on Rt. 37 across from Wild Bills.
5. Follow instructions located on the containers at the recycling depot and place your materials in the designated containers.
