**Procedural History**


On May 21, 2018, the Court received a letter from Peter J. Herne, counsel for [REDACTED] Gorrow and [REDACTED] as well as several others. The letter was also sent to Thomas B. Wheeler, counsel for the Petitioner and other parties. The letter requested clarification regarding the payment of the house insurance and utilities, which [REDACTED] Gorrow had been maintaining. The letter also included objections on behalf of [REDACTED] to the Administrator's Oath. Mr. Herne requested the objections be made part of the record. That request is granted and the letter is made part of the record.

**ORDER**

Until resolution of whether the contract entered into by the parties is valid and enforceable, Mr. [REDACTED] Gorrow is ORDERED to maintain and make the payments for the property insurance, electricity, and heat. Receipts for all the expenses he has made for the real property shall be itemized and turned over to the co-administrators to be included in the inventory.

Upon resolution of the contract issue, the Court will address whether these expenses shall be transferred to the co-administrators until the distribution of the Estate. And once the Court has the full inventory, the Court shall address the reimbursement of any expenses made by any of the heirs for the maintenance of the property.
