MOTION TO DISMISS


The Plaintiff in this matter, Ms. Ann Cook, has a motion before the Court to dismiss this action and remove herself from the matter. This motion was entered by the Plaintiff's Attorney, Ms. Lorraine White at a hearing in St. Regis Mohawk Tribal Court on May 16th, 2014.

The Court notes that all parties in the matter at bar were notified that there was a hearing to be held in St. Regis Mohawk Tribal Court on May 16th, 2014. Notification letters were sent out to all parties and follow up phone calls confirming this hearing date were also made to all parties involved.

The Defendant in this matter, Mr. Joseph Cook, did not appear for the scheduled hearing on May 16th, 2014. Upon the Defendant's non-appearance, attorney for Plaintiff, Ms. White, asked for a motion to dismiss based on Mr. Joseph Cook's continued absences from the proceedings.

Based upon Mr. Cook's continued behavior of non-compliance with the Court's procedures, and the Plaintiff's motion to dismiss the matter, the Court grants the motion to dismiss this matter, in favor of the Plaintiff, Ms. Ann Cook.
