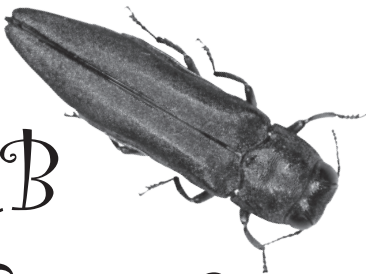


EAB Bingo



The Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe, Forestry Resource Program is calling out to the community for assistance in tracking the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) that is set to destroy all of our ash trees. Community members can participate by volunteering a tree on their property to be used as sentinel trap tree. Use the map to locate your property within a square. An inspection will be made to verify the location of the ash tree. Once verified, Forestry Resources will obtain address information and then girdle the tree this spring and cut it down in the fall. Property owners will be entered in a drawing for a new yard tree that will be planted and cared for by the program for two years. Only one tree is needed in each square so be the first to fill a square. Contact the Forestry Resources Program at (518) 358-5937 to participate.
