THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS APPLY IN ADDITION TO THOSE SPECIFIED ON THE REVERSE SIDE:			

THIS PERMIT IS VALID ONLY FOR SPECIFIED DATES AND ONLY FOR THE SPECIFIED OPEN BURN

Conditions:

- 1 Tires, fuel oil or similar materials that cause visible emissions shall not be used to ignite or sustain an open fire.
- 2 A restricted open fire is allowed only when the prevailing winds are away from populated areas. Fire shall not be started during heavy winds.
- 3 A permit holder shall not conduct open burning during any stage of an air pollution episode or when a period of high fire danger is announced by the local Tribal Authorities.
- 4 The permit holder shall have this permit available at site of open burning when burning is being conducted and shall show it to any person who requests to see it.
- 5 Materials to be ignited shall be isolated to prevent spreading and sufficient help must be present at all times to control fires.
- 6 No fire shall be unattended at any time or left unattended until entirely extinguished.
- 7 The permit holder shall be liable for damage to trees or other property resulting from fires ignited by him/her.
- 8 Should it become necessary to extinguish any fire, the permit holder shall pay the entire cost of suppression.
- 9 This permit is non-transferable and may be suspended if the permit holder fails to comply with the permit conditions.
- 10 Restricted burning shall not violate any applicable ambient air quality standard or cause air pollution
- 11 This permit is valid only where the permit holder owns the site of open fire or where he/she has secured permission from the site owner. This permit authorizes no trespassing on private property.
- 12 NO burns are to be done between March 15-May 15.
