Zoom Meetings

- Please log into the Tribal Members Portal at www.srmt-nsn.gov to obtain the Zoom Meeting link.
- If you wish to call-in, please contact Tribal Council's Office or our Communications Department at (518) 358-2272 to receive the phone number. *Please do not share the Meeting ID or telephone number with non-members.*
- Downloading the Zoom app is recommended. A dialog box will pop up in the browser requesting to open the app. If you do not allow the app to open, click "join by browser" on the main browser screen.
- Attendees may connect to the virtual meeting 5 minutes before the meeting is scheduled to start.
- If prompted enter the Meeting ID and your full name. Please click the box to join with video; you may turn your video off once the meeting starts if you wish.
- You will enter the waiting room and the meeting "host" will connect you to the meeting when it begins.
- The host will record the virtual meeting in order to publish to the Tribal Members Portal for those who could not participate in real time.
- The host will automatically mute all participants in order for the Chairperson to start the meeting.
- Participants may type questions in the chat box. A meeting moderator will call on participants to ask their question in the order raised.
- Please "raise your hand" if you wish to verbally ask a question.
- If you are calling in, please dial *9 to raise your hand. Please unmute yourself when asking a question. To unmute from a phone, please dial *6.
- The Rules of Personal Conduct for Meetings applies to virtual meetings and is available on the Tribal Members Portal for your review.
